THE DISTRICT

The French Camp Fire Protection District responds to approximately 2,200 calls for service a year. It provides Fire and EMS service to both the French Camp and Mountain House Communities in California's Central Valley. The combined service areas cover approximately twenty square miles and present hazards associated with high-density population centers, industrial complexes, major transportation corridors, health care facilities, and wildland interface.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

The French Camp Firefighter Candidate will possess the following minimum qualifications:

- 18 years of age or older
- High School diploma or GED
- California Driver's License
- Certified State of California EMT
- Possession of a Candidate Physical Abilities (CPAT) card obtained within the last 12 months.

DESIRABLE QUALIFICATIONS

- California State Firefighter I
- California State Firefighter II
- Driver / Operator 1A and 1B

BENEFIT PACKAGE

- The district contributes up to 100% of employee health, vision, and dental care plan.
